Winery Background

Dr. Konstantin Frank ignited the “Vinifera Revolution”, a movement that forever changed the course of wine growing in the Finger Lakes and the United States. Dr. Frank’s vision, knowledge and determination are credited with elevating the New York wine industry from a state of happy mediocrity to a level that today commands world attention. Located on Keuka lake in the Finger Lakes region, Dr. Konstantin Frank Wines features some of the oldest vinifera vines in the United States and continues to produce wines of distinction and quality.

Vinification

The fruit was picked in the early morning to retain freshness and fermented with specially selected German yeast at low temperatures in stainless steel tanks. A long, slow fermentation enhanced the delicate floral aromatics.

The Wine

Description: Expressive style with dominant characters of grapefruit, lime and star fruit notes. The crisp acidity enhances the distinct Keuka Lake minerality. All elements are perfectly balanced to make a wine that will last and continue improving for several years.

Style:	Dry with crisp mouth feel.
Body:	Light bodied
Vintage Influence:	Typical good year. Balance between fruit, delicate aromatics & structure.
Cellaring:	Drink now or cellar until 2019
Food Pairing:	Seafood, ceviche, oysters
Analysis:	Alcohol: 12.5%, Acidity: 0.7 g/100mL, 2.9 pH: , Sugar: 0.8%
