Winery Background:

Dr. Konstantin Frank Wine Cellars is New York's most award-winning winery since 1962. Dr. Konstantin Frank ignited the "Vinifera Revolution" a movement that forever changed the course of wine growing in the Finger Lakes and the United States. Dr. Frank's vision, knowledge and determination are credited with elevating the New York wine industry from a state of happy mediocrity to a level that today commands world attention. Located on the Keuka Wine Trail in the Finger Lakes region, Dr. Konstantin Frank Wine Cellars features some of the oldest vinifera vines in the United States and continues to produce wines of distinction and quality.

Vinification:

This particular wine is a blend of Pinot Noir. The Pinot Noir was picked late to enhance flavor development. After crushing and destemming, the Pinot Noir was fermented in open-top fermenters to allow punch-downs and pump-overs. After extended maceration, the grapes were pressed and the juice was settled. After malo-lactic fermentation, the wine was transferred to French oak barrels. Prior to bottling the wine was blended and egg-white fined.

Description:

This wine shows very good Pinot Noir character with vibrant raspberry and cherry fruit, soft tannins, lively acidity and a long, clean finish. This Pinot Noir shows the potential that Pinot Noir holds in the Finger Lakes region. A versatile wine, this Pinot Noir can be paired with duck breast, game dishes or more delicate fish and poultry dishes. This wine contains high levels of resveratrol with all of the associated health benefits.
