2015 Dry Riesling

“Cassis, blackberries, fresh herbs and spring blossom on the nose give this riesling from vineyards planted on slate soils on Keuka Lake a totally distinct personality. Although it is only medium-bodied, the racy energy, jewel-like brilliance and enormous mineral freshness on the finish make it a standout in the 2015 field! Drink now or age for up to a decade.”

2015 Semi-Dry Riesling

“Hailing from the “Banana Belt” of Seneca Lake, this medium-sweet riesling has very ripe peach, nectarine and apricot aromas and is quite full-bodied, but there’s enough acidic bite to provide some real tension and excitement.”

2014 Eugenia Dry Riesling

“The fennel-seed, herbal and white-peach aromas are only just opening up on this medium-bodied, rather steely wine from Dr. Frank’s old riesling vines, and although it’s more open on the palate, this long-distance runner is only just breaking into her stride! Better in 2018 or 2019. Since this is the first vintage, long-term ageing potential is difficult to assess.”
