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Chateau Frank 2009 Blanc de Noirs

The 2009 Blanc de Noirs “Chateau Frank” is Pinot Noir aged on the lees for about five years (this bottle was disgorged in June 2015-not noted on the bottle, but noted on the case, I’m told). Big, tight and rather powerful, this intense and crisp Pinot Noir is terrific for its clean and gripping finish. It takes no prisoners. It will probably do better with a little food. I loved the tension on the finish and the freshness on this sparkler.



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
