Winery Background

Dr. Konstantin Frank ignited the "Vinifera Revolution", a movement that forever changed the course of wine growing in the Finger Lakes and the United States. Dr. Frank's vision, knowledge and determination are credited with elevating the New York wine industry from a state of happy mediocrity to a level that today commands world attention. Located on Keuka lake in the Finger Lakes region, Dr. Konstantin Frank Wines features some of the oldest vinifera vines in the United States and continues to produce wines of distinction and quality.

Vinification

The fruit is gently pressed as soon as it gets to the winery. The juice is fermented in stainless steel tanks at low temperatures to preserve the more delicate flavors.

The Blend

A blend of Pinot Noir and Cabernet Franc

The Wine

Description: A soft, easy to drink dry rosé with notes of watermelon, strawberry and citrus

Style:	Fruit forward with great acidity
Body:	Light to medium bodied
Vintage Influence:	Fruit forward and soft
Maturation:	Stainless steel
Cellaring:	Drink now
Food Pairing:	Mild cheeses, grilled white fish, steamed shrimp

Analysis: Alcohol: 12%, pH = 3.33, Acidity = 5.4g/L Sugar = 0.5%
