2014 Semi-Dry Riesling - **92** Points

“An inviting, citrus scent leads into a semi-dry white that’s much warmer and rounder than the nose would suggest. The flavors have a pleasing breadth despite its racy, focused through-line. Give it a little time to come together, then serve with chicken paprikash.”



2014 Gewürztraminer - **91** Points

“A classic gewurz with a fresh, appealing lift and brightness of texture, this leads with scents of crushed rose petals and pineapple. While there’s plenty of ripe apple fruit, the lasting impression is of lanolin and minerals. A phenolic coolness of tone keeps the wine poised and exotic at once.”



Chateau Frank Célèbre Rosé- **89** Points

With its salmon-pink color, this is an attractive sparkler, its scent of strawberries framed by toasty lees. The flavors are crisp and fresh, with a clean, citrusy finish. Light enough to sip as an aperitif.
